Transportation: Departure time from school will be approximately 8:40 AM and return time around 4 PM.

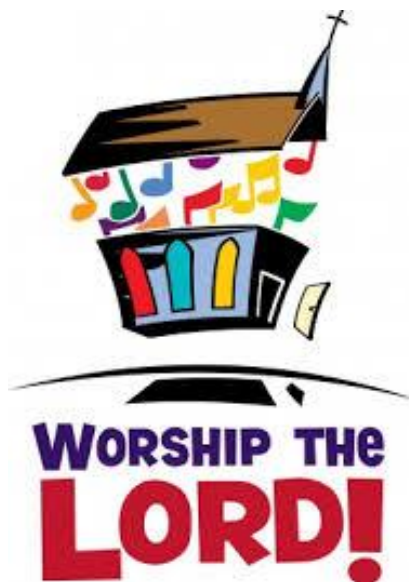
Chapel and Memory Work
