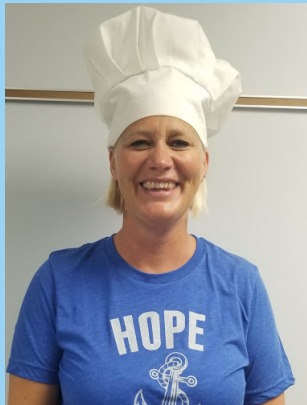

## NEW STAFF

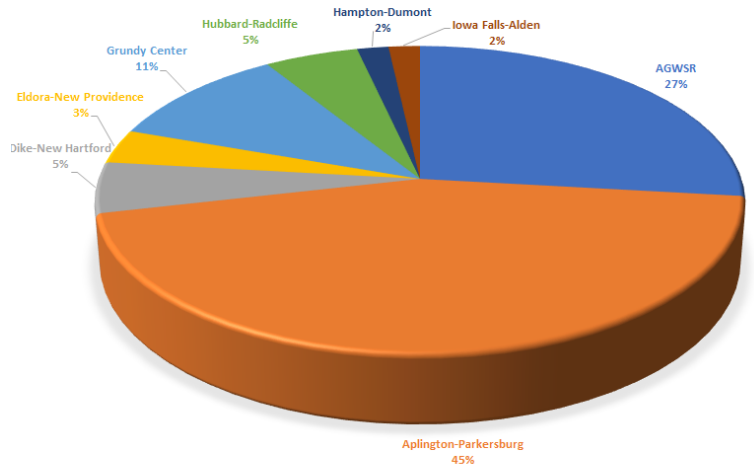

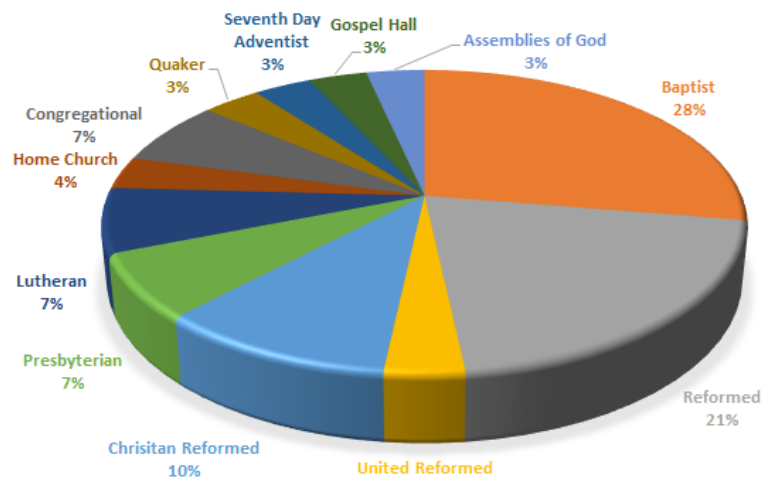

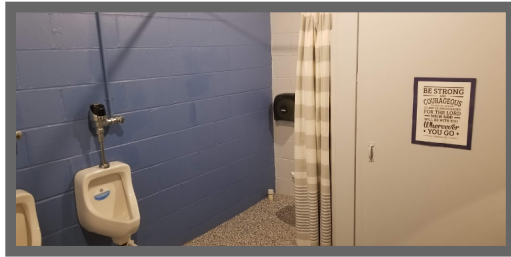
