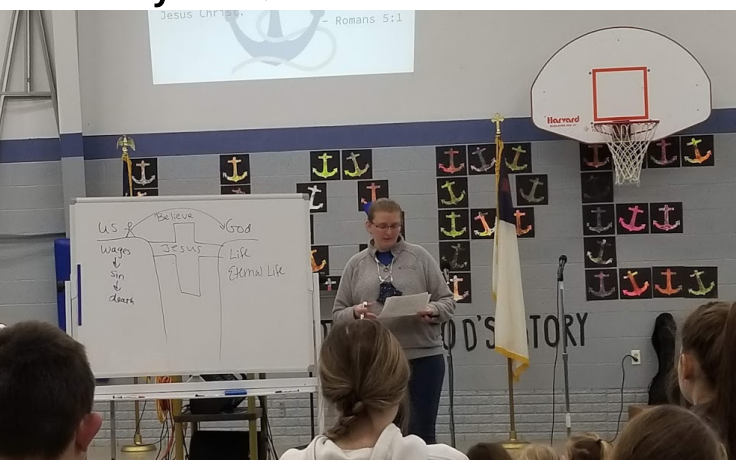

After rescheduling due to COVID-19 considerations and winter weather, our students were finally able to have an in-person music program on February 19. They did a great job!

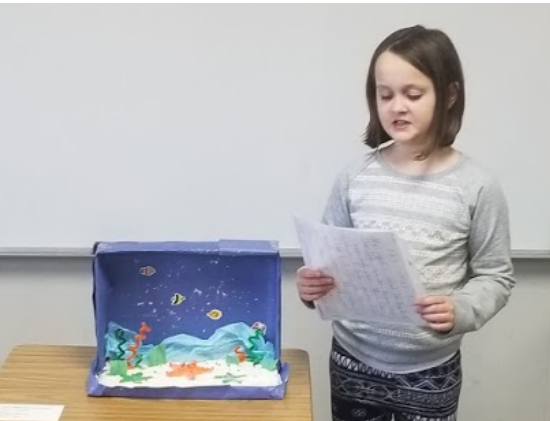

FUNDRAISERS

Approximately 40% of the school's operating budget is covered by tuition. The other 60% comes from donations and fundraisers. 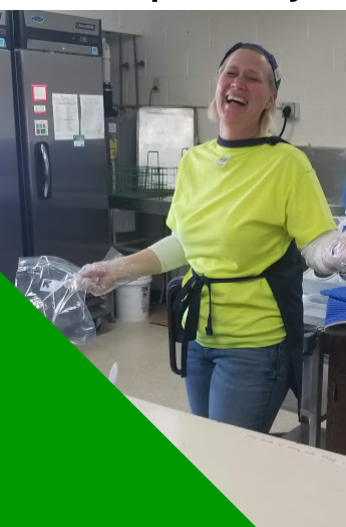
