Chapel and Memory Work:

This Week's Chapel: Praise the Lord for uplifting worship music to start off our Chapel this morning! A huge THANK YOU to Frank Figueroa, and his wife April, for blessing us with their message to be FOCUSED and DISCIPLINED. Frank and April come from Hawaii but have now traveled 76,000 miles sharing God's message. Their goal is "When it comes to Jesus, no one gets left behind." Frank encouraged everyone to focus on the right prize, heavenly things, not perishable, earthly things. Frank and April are active in archery and started Centershot, a free program that reaches out to the youth (ages 8-18) of Hawaii using their archery skills not only to make them better archers, but also disciples of Jesus. Regarding focus, Frank used the example of Matt Emmons, an American Olympic archer, who lost his focus and shot his opponent's target instead of his own to lose the gold medal.
