Chapel and Memory Work:

This Week's Chapel: Thank you to Pastor Bryce Roskens from the Steamboat Rock Baptist Church for sharing with us today. Pastor Bryce spoke about the power of the tongue. The Bible speaks of it. Look at James 3:5 "Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark." Pastor Bryce shared a childhood story of playing with his cousin on a gravel road in South Dakota. They had a firework that they would light, it would jump around, and shoot a color. They were lighting another firework when they heard crackling. The ditch was on fire! They ran to get their parents and grandparents who were close by. When they got back, the ditch AND the field were on fire. A small spark can spread quickly; our tongue has that same power! Pastor Bryce's things to remember: 1) be slow to speak and quick to listen, 2) remember that MY words have power, 3) choose to change (How are your friends talking? How are they behaving? Change what is in your heart and even the people you spend your time with. Remember, garbage in, garbage out.), and 4) ask God to be in your heart and help you. Check out our Facebook page for more.
