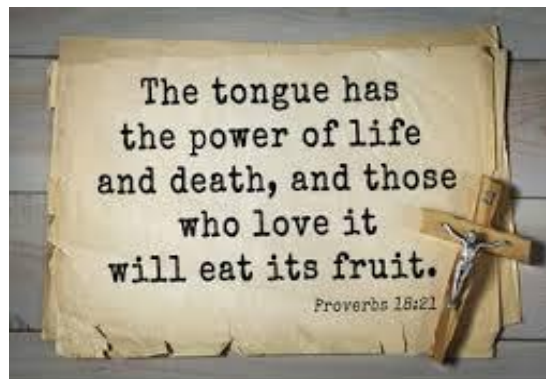
Chapel and Memory Work:
