AUCTION RAFFLE - TIME TO SELL TICKETS! Information on the back...

Tickets: In today's packet, you will find a brown envelope with 8 Winner's Choice raffle tickets, a description of the trips available to win, and raffle rules. Each ticket is to be sold for \$50. There are rules set out by the State of Iowa for selling raffle tickets, so please read through the information in the raffle envelope. Try to sell all 8; however, if you truly cannot, they must be returned to Diane no later than **Monday, March 2**. ALL tickets must be accounted for! ALL tickets must be either returned with payment or returned unsold.

Winner's Choice Raffle and Trips: A Winner's Choice Raffle is when the winner of the raffle gets to choose 1 trip from a selection of trips. In your envelope is information about the trips the winner will be able to choose between: 1) Family Space Adventure: Kennedy Space Center, 2) Banff Family Adventure: Adventure in the Canadian Rockies, 3) Charming Charleston, 4) The fourth "trip" is a winner's choice in itself. If the winner chooses this one, the winner gets to choose between Kauai, Cancun, Jackson Hole, or Lake Tahoe. So, there are really 7 trips to choose from this year!

Purchaser Tickets and Money: Give the purchaser the large part of the ticket and return the small portion of the ticket, with payment, to Diane. When returning to Diane, please put the money and ticket stubs in an envelope so neither money nor tickets get lost.

Money and Ticket Stubs Due: Sold tickets, along with payment, are due to Diane on **Wednesday, March 11**.

Unsold Tickets Due: If it is impossible to sell all your tickets, return them no later than **Monday, March 2**, so someone else can try to sell them. Please give this your best effort; we are only asking each family to sell 8 this year. If you sell more, please contact Diane, and she will see who has some for you to sell.

Raffle Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1) Is there 1 winner or 1 winner per trip? There will be 1 winner drawn, and that winner will be able to choose which of the 7 trips they want to take.
- 2) Does the winner need to be present to win? No. Diane will livestream on Facebook as Lindsay Wolff holds the ticket bucket while 1 TC student draws the name of the winner. It will be announced live on Facebook, and the winner will receive a phone call.
- 3) Can a person buy all of my 8 tickets? Yes. One person can buy as many tickets as they would like.
- 4) How long does the winner have to take the trip? The winner has 1 year to take the trip. The company TC works with to plan the trips will work with the winner to make the arrangements. They have been a great company to work with!
