AUCTION RAFFLE - TIME TO SELL TICKETS!

Tickets: Each ticket is to be sold for \$50. There are rules set out by the State of Iowa for selling raffle tickets, so please read through the information in the raffle envelope. Try to sell all 8; however, if you truly cannot, they must be returned to Diane no later than **Monday, March 2**. ALL tickets must be accounted for! ALL tickets must be either returned with payment or returned unsold.

Winner's Choice Raffle and Trips: A Winner's Choice Raffle is when the winner of the raffle gets to choose 1 trip from a selection of trips. This year's winner will be able to choose between: 1) Family Space Adventure: Kennedy Space Center, 2) Banff Family Adventure: Adventure in the Canadian Rockies, 3) Charming Charleston, 4) The fourth "trip" is a winner's choice in itself.
