Do the kids like them? YES! Here are some thoughts from the students:



"I enjoy being able to hear how I can pray for other students."

HOELSCHER'S Happenings



At Timothy Christian, we have the wonderful opportunity to see God in all parts of our lives, including math, science, language, music, and art. As we learn about school subjects, we also learn about God and how to live out our faith. Our theme for this year is "Walk by Faith" and our main Bible verse is 2nd Corinthians 5:7, For we walk by faith, not by sight. It can be hard, as Christians, to walk in faith when we can't see God or don't know the direction He wants to take us. I know, for me, it is difficult to walk through life in faith, when there are so many unknowns. But if we knew everything, we wouldn't need faith. Hebrews 11:1 tells us Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. Our faith grows deeper when we trust God to guide us when we can't "see" or know what is next. I like to think of it like a GPS. We know where we are and where we are going, but we don't always know how we are going to get there. We trust the GPS to show us the way, but there may be unexpected things along the way. Road work, an accident that slows traffic, road closures. Or maybe we missed an exit and we hear "recalculating". Whatever challenges we face along the way, we know the GPS will guide us to our destination. It can be similar with God and our faith. We know our destination as believers, Heaven. We can trust God to guide us along the way. However we may run into challenges that slow us down, distract us, or maybe our sins and wrong choices have caused us to "miss an exit" and God needs to get our attention by "recalculating" to get us back on track. The question is, do we trust God to guide us when we don't know what's coming up next? When we can't "see"? Are we willing to walk by faith and not by sight and trust God to show us the path to take? We can if we follow the wisdom of Proverbs 3:5-6, Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.
